S&P Global awarded Poste Italiane the score of 96/100 in the Social section for its policies and practices of attracting and developing talent, protecting human rights and financial inclusion. Furthermore, with reference to the "Governance" dimension, the Group has been awarded for the ethical and transparent conduct of the business, for the practices related to risk management and cyber security, while it has distinguished itself in the "Environmental" dimension for the solidity of its climate strategy.

Standard & Poor's Global compares companies from 61 industries by judging companies' sustainability performance overall. The rating assigned by S&P Global to companies works as a preliminary assessment basis to establish their entry in the Dow Jones Sustainability World Index and Dow Jones Sustainability Europe Index.
